

CROATIAN WHITES

Pošip is an indigenous Dalmatian white variety, and the first Croatian white wine with protected geographic origin since 1967. It thrives in the south of the island of Korcula; specifically areas "Smokvica" and "Cara", where it achieves the highest quality. The wine is the colour of straw with a full and distinctive flavour, and a characteristic aroma of dried apricots and figs.

Strong (poignant) and pleasant smell of almonds in bloom and wild vegetation.

CROATIAN REDS

Plavac Mali is the most important Croatian autochthonous variety. Its wine is dark ruby colour with blue reflection and a well-developed scent. Vigorous and sharp tasting with a very specific taste. The best reds come from the Peljesac Peninsula, from the south side of the island of Hvar and Brac, and from some good parts of the island Vis.

ISTRIA & COASTAL CROATIAN WHITES

Žlahtina is an indigenous Croatian variety of white grapes. Its name is derived from the Slavic adjective meaning "noble". It is mostly grown in the Vrbnik field on the island of Krk.

The wine is a light yellow color with greenish reflections, which is typical of the Riesling variety. The smell is extremely fruity whilst the taste is mineral, warm and fresh. Very popular throughout Croatia, especially in the continental parts.

It smells of purified fruit while leaving a dry, warm and fresh mineral taste in the mouth.
